SINGLES

Handicap will be 80% of 210, with a maximum handicap of 32 pins per game

Bowl 8 qualifying games across 8 pair of lanes

Sunday Finals - Double elimination bracket finals, 2 game total pinfall matches

Cut to top 8 with at least 40 entries

With less than 40 Queens entries, number of advancers will be adjusted according to a working bracket

With at least 40 Queens entries, the highest senior bowler (age 50+) assured to advance

There must be at least 5 senior entries to assure an advancer

LANE CONDITION

Both the Queens and Masters will bowl together on a Challenge compliant lane condition
which will be revealed the week of the tournament

ENTRY FEES

\$225 if paid in full by July 18, 2026

\$275 after July 18, 2026

All late fees added to prize fund

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all current USBC members in good standing

Any bowler currently not a member of NTXUSBC would be required to pay a \$15 local association fee

Youth bowlers may not enter

2026 North Texas USBC Queens

1. Queens is open to all current USBC members, in good standing. Any member not current part of NTXUSBC wishing to enter may do so by paying the \$15 NTXSUBC Local Association Fee. Youth members may not enter.
2. This tournament will be a singles tournament, with handicap being 80% of 210, and a maximum handicap of 32 pins per game. The average used will be the bowler's highest 2025-26 USBC Average of at least 21 games.
3. All entry fees must accompany entry form in full. Prizes will be returned 100%. Pay ratio in each division will be 1 in 5 entries. Entry fee will be \$225 (Prize fund - \$175, Lineage & Expenses \$50), if paid by July 18, 2026. Entry fee will be \$275 (Prize fund - \$225, Lineage & Expenses \$50) after July 18.
4. Format will be 8 games of qualifying across 8 pair of lanes on Saturday, July 25th at 9am for A squad, or 2:30pm for B squad, with the finals being a Double Elimination, 2-game total pinfall, bracket finals on Sunday, July 26th at 9am.
 - With at least 40 Queens entries, 8 bowlers will advance. With less than 40 entries, advancing numbers will be adjusted according to working bracket.
5. All bracket matches are 2 games, total pinfall. Any ties after 2 games will be broken by a single ball, sudden death roll-off, with the bowlers shooting on the lane they finished game 2 on. Bowlers will switch lanes and continue if they remain tied after first shot, and repeat until the tie is broken. Higher seed chooses order of roll-off. No Handicap will be associated in a sudden death roll-off.
6. Any ties for final advancing spot will be broken by a one game roll-off, immediately following qualifying. If two squads are conducted, and a tie occurs, the single game will be after squad 2. It is the bowler's responsibility to be present and ready in the occurrence of a tie. Ties for seeding will be broken by the highest qualifying game. If the bowlers have the same high game, it will go to the next highest game(s) until tie is broken.
7. The tournament will be conducted with 1 qualifying squad on Saturday, July 25th at 10am, with the Queens and Masters bowlers qualifying together, with pairs consisting of bowlers from both events.
8. Finals will begin promptly at 9am on Sunday, July 26th. Any bowler not present inside of Bowlero Eules at 9am will forfeit their finals spot and prize money associated, and an alternate will take their place in their qualifying position. Only bowlers who were within 5 spots of final advancing spot will be eligible as alternates. If no alternate present, a bye will be inserted into the bracket should a bowler not be present.
9. Lane Condition: The lanes will be conditioned with oil patterns that are USBC Challenge compliant, between a 4:1 and 8:1 oil ratio. The patterns will be revealed the week of the tournament.
10. Dress Code: Bowlers must wear a bowling polo, bowling jersey or bowling henley, and must have sleeves. Name shirts are encouraged, but not required. Long pants, jeans without holes, golf shorts, capri pants, skirts or skorts permitted. No t-shirts, tank tops, cut off jeans, cargo shorts or pants, gym shorts or joggers permitted. No hats permitted. Any clothing with obscene words, gestures or images will be strictly prohibited. Tournament director has final say on all apparel.
11. All USBC approved bowling balls will be permitted.
12. All USBC Rules not covered will be in effect.
